£100.00 per provider group per year Stand alone homes with less than 10 beds or 20 beds will pay £25.00 or £50.00 respectively.



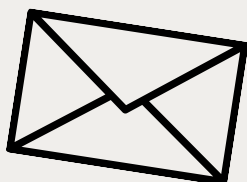

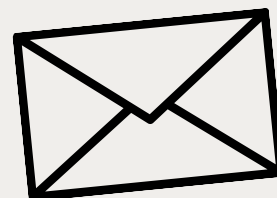
